

Chatterbox Game - *What do I want to be when I grow up?* (Ages pre-school and Primary)



Instructions to play:

1. Cut off the instruction panel where indicated
2. Fold outer corners to the back along the diagonal lines (so you are left with a central square)
3. Turn over so the folded-in sections are now facing you
4. Fold each pointed edge under so you are left with a square shape with the question (*What do I want to be when I grow up?*) facing you
5. Turn over
6. Fold in half vertically to create a crease then open back to square shape
7. Fold in half horizontally to create a crease and open back to square shape
8. Insert your thumb and forefinger on each hand under each flap to form a peak
9. Now you are ready to play.
10. While asking the question - *What do I want to be when I grow up?* move your fingers in and out moving the chatterbox for each word of the question
11. When you stop, read the four options and choose one (for example - *feed people*) then guess the occupation and open the chatterbox to see if you guessed the occupation correctly (cheer).



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
