

NCDW 2009 Event Story from Whyalla Career Development Centre

What is your event story?

The Whyalla Career Development Centre partnered with Career Employment Group, Uni SA, Tafe SA, Uniting Care Wesley PA, Interwork, National Disability Coordination Officer, Employment Plus, Skills Recognition Services, Settlement Services, Access Working Careers and Aboriginal Employment Initiatives to host a week of events for National Career Development Week, 18-22 May. The week delivered five key focus days, they included; Career Journey, Aboriginal, Migrant, Apprenticeships/Traineeships and Disabilities. Specialist representatives were available to provide information on training, funding and employment options. 60 participants attended through the week taking the opportunity to learn about themselves and reconnect with their careers, skills and ultimately be empowered.
